

3M Cloud Library for Sony Readers

Setting up your accounts and computer:

1. Download and install the 3M Cloud Library application onto your computer here:

2. Download and install Adobe Digital Editions here:
<http://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions/download.html>
3. Register for an Adobe ID here: <https://accounts.adobe.com/>

Setting up your 3M Cloud Library app:

1. When you first open your 3M Cloud Library application, follow the prompts to login.
2. When asked if you would like to activate your Adobe ID, enter your username and password and click activate.
3. Browse and borrow eBooks.
4. From the 3M Cloud Library app, go to My Books, and open your borrowed item(s). This prompts the authentication process associated with your Adobe ID.

Transferring to your Sony reader:

1. Turn on your Sony Reading and connect it to your computer using a USB cable.
2. Select “Yes” when asked to recognize device.
3. Locate the “My Digital Editions” folder in your Windows Explorer (Windows) or Finder (Mac). Look for the eBook file of the borrowed book you wish to transfer.
4. Locate your Sony Reader device icon that will also appear in your Windows Explorer (Windows) or Finder (Mac).
5. Drag the eBook file from the “My Digital Editions” folder and drop it into your Sony Reader folder. The eBook file should now appear in your Sony Reader folder on your computer.
6. Eject your Sony Reader from your computer and begin reading.

Troubleshooting Adobe Digital Editions (ADE)

If you chose ‘automatically generate ID’ for 3M Cloud Library in the past, you need to reauthorize ADE.

1. In ADE, press Ctrl + Shift + D.
2. Select “Erase Authorization”.
3. From the Help menu, enter your Adobe ID and password.

Next, delete the 3M Cloud Library cache

1. From your Start Menu, search %appdata%
2. Delete the 3M Cloud Library folder.
3. Open 3M Cloud Library and login.
4. Provide your Adobe ID and password when prompted.

Lastly, authorize your eReader

1. Open ADE and plug in your eReader to your computer using a USB cable.
2. You should be prompted by ADE to change the eReader authorization with the current ADE authorization. If not, press Ctrl + Shift + E to force a deauthorization of the eReader.
