

Planning Process

Library Board Planning and Development Committee

The Committee was tasked by the Library Board to develop the next strategic plan, that started with recommending a three-year term for the plan, followed by a review of the Mission, Vision, and Values Statements.

Phone Survey of Residents

To gauge both user and non-user needs, the Library Board commissioned a multi-language survey of Coquitlam residents.

In-House User Survey

Over a three week period, more than 700 customers of the Library, both in-house and online, completed a survey. This survey was used to review current services and the customers' perceptions of the Library.

Library Board and Management Team Planning Meeting

The Library Board and the Management Team met to review the survey outcomes, current trends in library services and priorities, and to select a series of strategic goals.

Senior Staff Objectives Development Meeting

The Library's management and supervisors met to review the survey outcomes and the Library Board's strategic goals, and to develop a series of objectives on how the Library could meet these goals.

Cross-Disciplinary Staff Working Groups Review

Cross-disciplinary staff teams met to review the Goals and Objectives and provide feedback and recommendations on changes.

Approval of the 2016–2018 Strategic Plan

The Planning Committee met to review the final draft and recommended that the Library Board approve the Library's 2016–2018 Strategic Plan.
