Libby by OverDrive

Libby is compatible with most computers, tablets, smartphones, and eReaders. The layout of the app may look different on different devices.

USING LIBBY ON A TABLET OR SMART PHONE:

- 1. Download the Libby app through your device's app store.
- 2. Follow the prompts to search for Coquitlam Public Library
- 3. Enter your library card number with no spaces.
- 4. Enter your PIN (usually the last 4-digits of your phone number).
- 5. Tap on Sign In.
- 6. Browse, search, borrow, and read or listen to books directly from the Libby app.

The navigation menu located at the bottom of the app includes Search, Library, Menu, Shelf, and Timeline.

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Search	Library	Menu	Shelf	Timeline


Search allows you to search for a title or author, see recent searches, or use filters to browse the collection.

Library displays the library's whole collection. It includes curated collections, such as most popular items or mysteries.

Menu is where you can add additional library cards, switch between libraries, or change your settings. You can logout here by tapping Manage Cards, Actions, and then Remove Card.

Shelf displays items checked out to you, items on hold, or smart tags you may have set up. You can read or return items here.

Timeline displays your borrowing history.



Item: When you tap on a book cover, you can click Borrow to check out the item or **Read Sample** to read a short excerpt of the book. If the item has been checked out by someone else, click on **Place Hold** to add item to your Holds List.

If you tap on the digital library card symbol in the lower right corner, it will display an estimated wait time before the title will be available, and how many loans and holds you have on your digital library card.

USING LIBBY ON A COMPUTER:

METHOD 1: THROUGH YOUR INTERNET BROWSER

- 1. Go to coglibrary.ca
- 2. Under Borrow It, click on eReads & Audiobooks.
- 3. Locate Libby by OverDrive and then click Go to Libby.

USING LIBBY ON AN EREADER:

Libby is integrated with newer Kobo devices to make it easier to borrow titles from the library. If your Kobo is integrated, follow Method 1. If your Kobo or other eReader is not integrated, follow Method 2.

METHOD 1: USING LIBBY ON A KOBO EREADER

- 1. On your Kobo, tap More, then Settings, and then OverDrive.
- 2. Tap Get Started and then Sign in to OverDrive
- 3. Search for Coquitlam Public Library and select it.
- 4. Enter your library card number (no spaces) and PIN.
- 5. Tap Browse or Search to look for available titles.
- 6. On the **Discover** tab, OverDrive will be selected at the top of your screen.
- 7. Find something you want to read and tap the title.
- 8. Tap the three-dot button. Tap **Place a Hold** or **Borrow with OverDrive**.
- 9. Tap Go to Books or go to My Books to find the borrowed title and start reading.

METHOD 2: TRANSFERRING EBOOKS TO EREADERS USING ADOBE DIGITAL EDITIONS

- 1. Download Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) for Windows or Mac.
- 2. Borrow an eBook through Libby in your web browser. Click on the Download EPUB link to download your eBook.
- 3. Open ADE. Click Help and then Authorize Computer. Follow the prompts to create an Adobe ID.
- 4. In ADE, click Help again and Authorize Computer. Enter your newly created Adobe ID and password. Click Authorize.
- 5. Plug your eReader into your computer using a USB cable. Click **Connect** on your eReader when prompted.
- 6. In ADE, right click on your eReader where it appears under **Devices** and click **Authorize Device**.
- 7. Open the eBook file you downloaded earlier. It should open automatically in ADE. Go to Library and choose All Items.
- 8. Click and then drag and drop your eBook to your eReader under **Devices**.
- 9. The ADE app will notify you when the transfer is successful. Unplug your eReader and start reading!

OTHER NOTES:

- You can borrow up to 15 items and place up to 15 holds at one time.
- If an item is eligible for renewal, a 'Renew' button will appear on your Shelf before the due date.
- After books have been downloaded to your device, you may read them offline (without Internet connection).
