# **Call for Entries**

Artists based in the Tri-Cities, including Coquitlam, Port Moody, Port Coquitlam, and Belcarra, are invited to submit two-dimensional works in the mediums of paintings, drawings, photographs, collage, and prints.

There are two age categories: Youth (12 – 16) and Adult (17+).

Selected works will be displayed at the City Centre branch from Thursday, Sept. 26 to Wednesday, Nov. 6.

#### Theme

The theme is "Openness" and "Curiosity" – two of Coquitlam Public Library's essential values:

- **Openness:** To ideas, to differences, to possibility.
- **Curiosity:** We are always asking: What would happen? How could it be better? What if...?

Artists are invited to explore the spirit of curiosity and openness and show their interpretation of these themes in the works they submit to the Juried Art Exhibit.

#### **Inclusion and Diversity Statement**

We acknowledge with gratitude and respect that the name Coquitlam was derived from the handdaminam (HUN-kuh-MEE-num) word kwikwaldam (kwee-KWET-lum) meaning "Red Fish Up the River". The Coquitlam Public Library is honoured to be located on the kwikwaldam traditional and ancestral lands, including those parts that were historically shared with the diday (kat-zee), and other Coast Salish Peoples.

We value the diversity that exists within our community and welcome applications from Indigenous artists, people of colour, LGBTQ2S+ individuals, people with disabilities, and individuals of all socioeconomic backgrounds. Works by Indigenous artists may be prioritized.



By providing a platform for the artistic expression of often marginalized communities, we can help break down barriers and promote inclusivity and diversity. Join us in our efforts to celebrate the artistic talent of all members of our community.

### **Rules for Entries**

- Entries must be two-dimensional works including, but not limited to, paintings, drawings, photographs, collages, and prints.
- Our display space allows us to accept works with the following dimensions:
  - o 24 x 30 inches and less than 20 lbs (34 works total)
  - 36 x 36 inches and less than 20 lbs (12 works total)
- Entries must be original artwork created within the last four years (2020 2024)
- Works must be dry, framed, and/or otherwise ready to hang on a hook
- Artists may submit up to two works for consideration
- All accepted works must remain on display for the duration of the exhibit
- Artists must sign a Photo Release Form allowing Coquitlam Public Library to take and use photos of them and/or their artwork

#### **Important Deadlines**

Applications must be received in full by Sunday, Jul. 7 at 9:00 pm.

Successful applicants will be notified by Monday, Sept. 16.

Accepted works must be installed and ready to display by Wednesday, Sept. 25 at 8:00 p.m.

An opening reception will be held on Saturday, Sept. 28.

Works will be available for pick-up after the conclusion of the exhibit, beginning **Thursday**, **Nov. 7**. Library staff will coordinate individual pick-up times with each artist.

# **Display Period and Exhibition Installation**

The Juried Art Exhibition will be held at Coquitlam Public Library's City Centre branch, 1169 Pinetree Way. The exhibition will be open to the public from Thursday, Sept. 26 until Wednesday, Nov. 6.

Successful artists must bring their accepted works to the Library for installation on one of the following dates:

- Tuesday, Sept. 24: 1:30 pm 8:00 pm
- Wednesday, Sept. 25: 1:30 pm 8:00 pm



Library staff will be on site to assist with installation. Panels, hooks, and all other equipment will be supplied by the Library.

# **How We Will Support Your Work**

Selected works will be securely displayed throughout the City Centre branch of Coquitlam Public Library, giving artists a unique opportunity to showcase their work to the Tri-Cities community. In addition, we will recognize select works through:

- The People's Choice Awards (one work each from the Youth and the Adult category)
- Highlighting three to five works that stood out to the jury

Artists, visitors and the general public will have the opportunity to cast their votes for the People's Choice Award while the exhibit is open. Both the People's Choice Award winners and the works that stand out to the jury will be displayed at the Library for an extended period after the exhibit closes.

An opening reception will be held on Saturday, Sept. 28 at the City Centre branch. More information will be released on coqlibrary.ca.

#### Jurors

A panel of three jurors will review the applications for inclusion in the Juried Art Exhibition. The panel will include:

- One staff member from the Art Gallery at Evergreen
- One member of the Coquitlam Public Library Community Advisory Group
- One staff member from Place des Arts
