RE: King Albert Greenway Project Phase Three

The City awarded a contract to Arise Contracting Inc. to construct the next phase of the King Albert Greenway project. This project will improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians and cyclists. Please refer to the project route map on the reverse side of this letter.

This phase of construction is taking place from Poirier Street to Hillcrest Street. The scope of work includes:

- The installation of a new 3.0 metre wide asphalt multi-use pathway along:
 - The **south side** of the Coquitlam Public Library parking lot connecting to Laurentian Crescent;
 - The **north side of Lemax Avenue** from Laurentian Crescent to Midvale Street;
 - The **west side of Midvale Street** from Lemax Avenue to King Albert Avenue; and
 - The **north side of King Albert Avenue** from Midvale Street to Hillcrest Street;
- New pathway lighting and street lighting, including beacon flashers for major pedestrian crossings;
- New signage and restoration work.

Construction is expected to begin in late August and will take approximately three months to complete, weather dependent. Construction will begin at Poirier Street and work east to Hillcrest Street. Work will take place Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., with potential Saturday work.

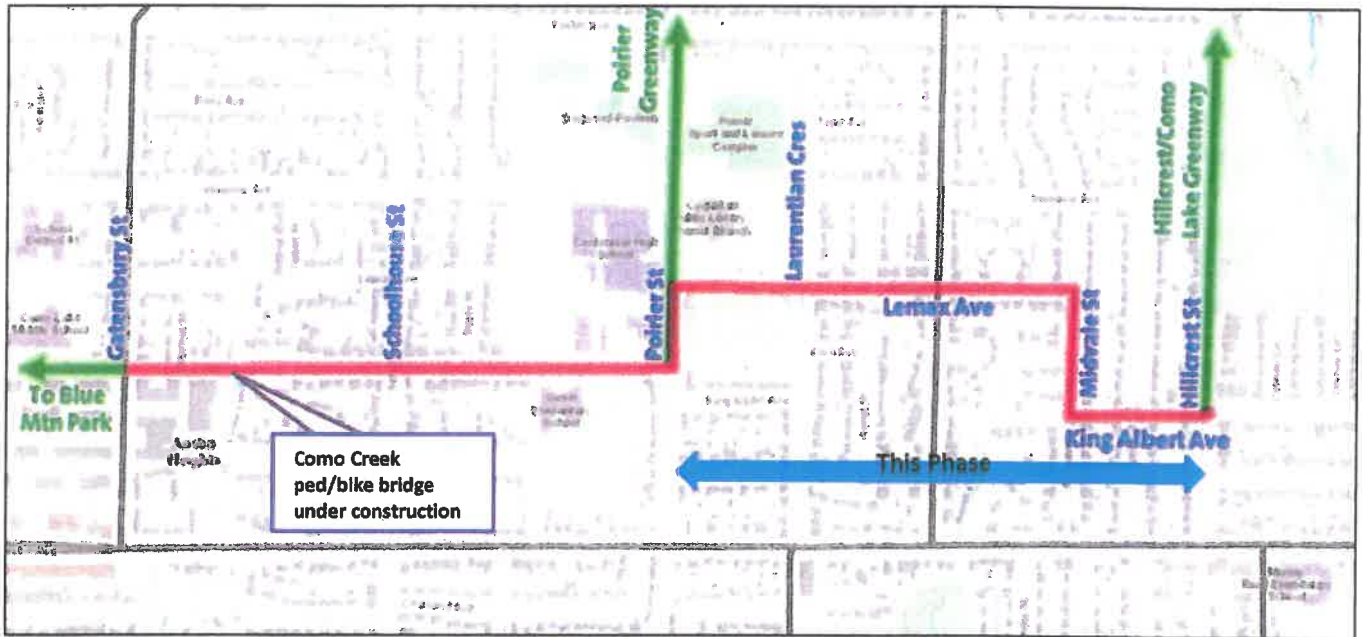
